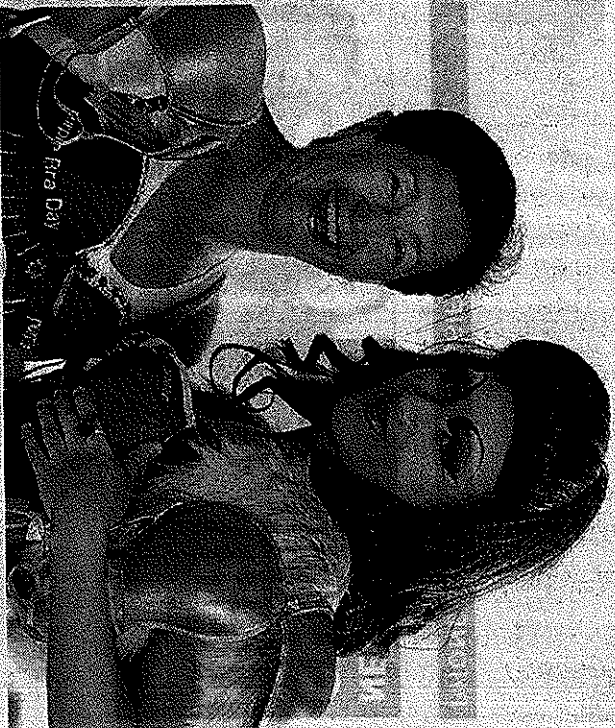

Breast cancer sufferers, their families, community members, local schoolchildren and drag queen Lady Anna-Thrax will gather at Trigg Surf Club on Friday June 17, for the event.

Ms Bontempo, a breast cancer survivor, said she organised the event because it was a great chance to have some fun while raising money for a good cause.

"I was diagnosed with breast cancer in 2008 and battled the disease for three years," she said.

"My greatest support was my family and I had a lot of help from my community, especially Chrystalis Montessori School, this is my way of giving back."

Saint George Hotel in Innaloo is also getting in on the action with a fashion show and staff members decked-out in purple bras.

The hotel is taking gold-coin donations on the day and all tips will go to Breast Cancer WA.
